Referrals and how your doctor can help...

You may be able to get help from the community physiotherapist, depending on your problem. You will need to see your GP first as access to them requires a referral from your doctor.

Ask reception for more information and a telephone number. You will need your NHS number to access this service. Again, the receptionist can help you with this.

It is usually advisable to speak to your GP in the first instance as there may be a service more appropriate for you.

The British Red Cross



The British Red Cross are able to loan equipment to you. This is available for up to 3 months after which time you may purchase this equipment at a reduced cost. The initial cost of hire is usually low, however the price will obviously vary according to what you require from them.

They are able to sell equipment out right to you also at a reduced cost. You may buy this brand new, or they offer reconditioned equipment at a further reduced cost.

The Red Cross are able to measure you for walking sticks and provide other relevant services.

They are contactable on 0845 331 3331. In Exeter they are based at Bradbury House, Apple Lane, Sowton Industrial Estate, Exeter.
